


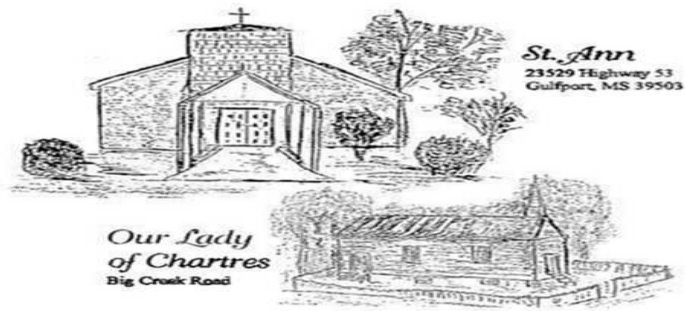

He was given his name eight days after his birth. Then in accord with the dictates of the law as found in Exodus 13:2, he was presented to God as were all first-born sons. The The son was purchased back into the family by a gift at the temple; the gift would be a pair of doves or a lamb, depending on the wealth of the family. Today's Mass is sometimes called Candlemas because there is a special blessing to church candles this day.
