Dear Parishioners and Friends,

In the name of all of us, I'd like to thank all those who put so much time, effort, and talent into our Holy Week and Easter celebrations. Special thanks are extended to all of our cantors, choirs, musicians. We are indeed blessed with musical talent, combined with the generosity in sharing their God-given talent with all of us. Special thanks are also extended to our Liturgy committee who helped with all of our Holy Week services, to our RCIA team who prepared those who entered our church community at the

Easter Vigil, and all who lent their talent to decorate our church so well for Holy Week and Easter. More thanks go to our sacristans, liturgical ministers (Eucharistic ministers, Lectors, ushers, greeters, and altar servers) and to our staff, maintenance, landscaping and housekeeping personnel whose "knowhow" we count on so much throughout the year.

Please note that I will join the annual priest retreat of our diocese this week from Monday evening, March 28 through Thursday March 31 so we do not have a Mass for Tuesday through Thursday at both Churches.
