

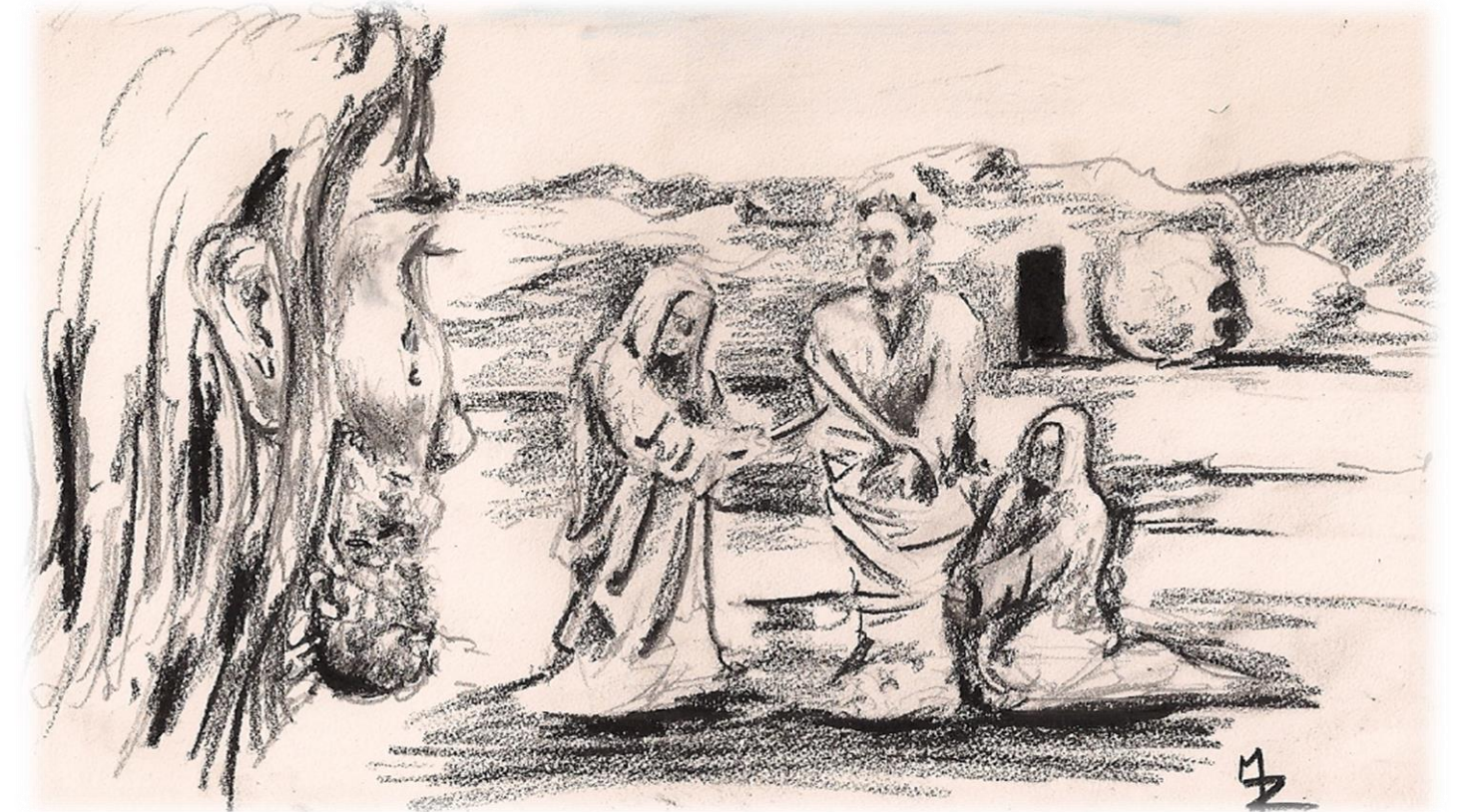
Heavenly Father,
