In 1925 Pope Pius XI promulgated his encyclical "Quas Primas." Declaring the 34th Sunday in Ordinary Time as The Solemnity of Christ The King.

The Society of the 1920's had many difficulties, there were many changes in politics, social economic and in the industrial development.

Pope Pous XI recognized that the church was also having their own difficulties. People were doing their own thing and turning away from the church.

Our time is no different, people are falling away from our God, who loves us. Discipline in the faith, in life, in families, in neighbors and in friends do not bear witness to the Gospel of Christ.

The revival of the Eucharist is our call to rally the troops, to come back to the table of the Lord.

What are you willing to do? "Lord, may Your will be done on earth as it is in Heaven."
