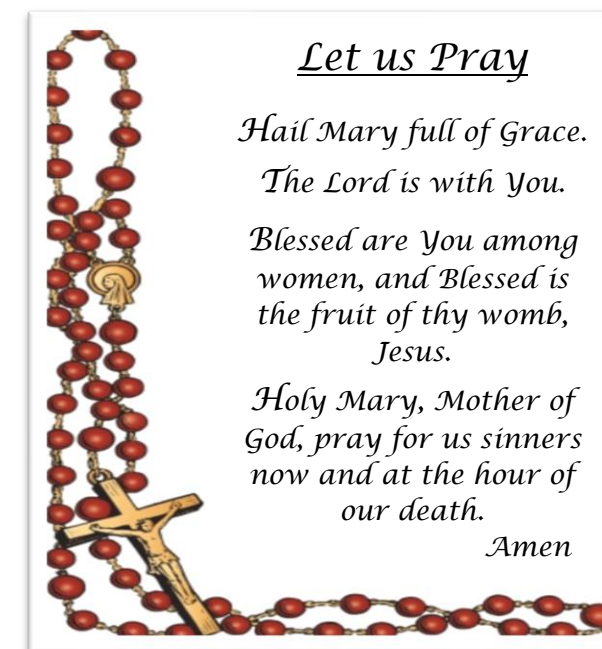
The evening begins with Adoration at 5:00pm, prayer at 5:40 and mass beginning at 6:30. The presentation by Edward Barr will followed the mass.
