The Healing Face of Jesus

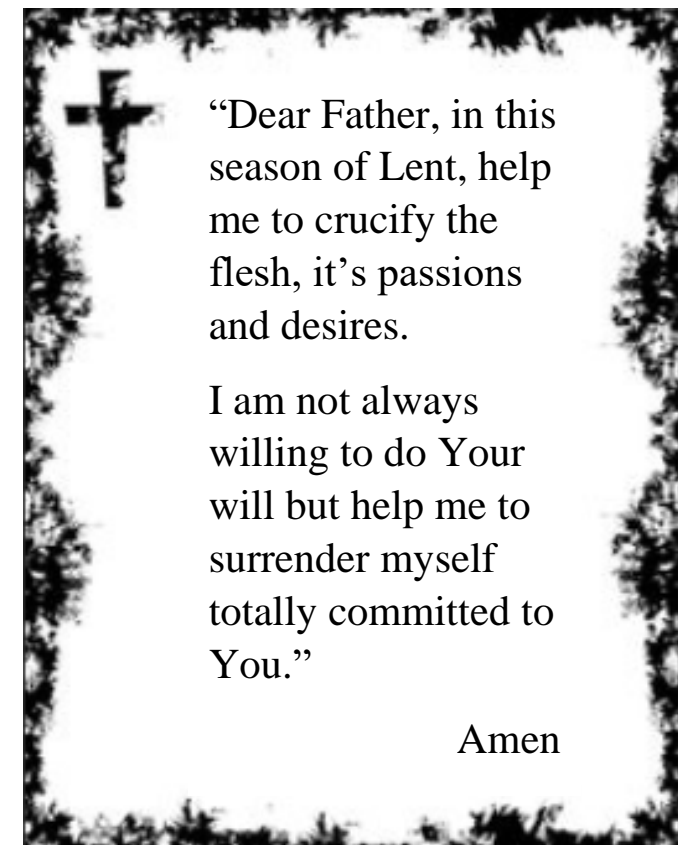
