shrouds them as garments of grief.*

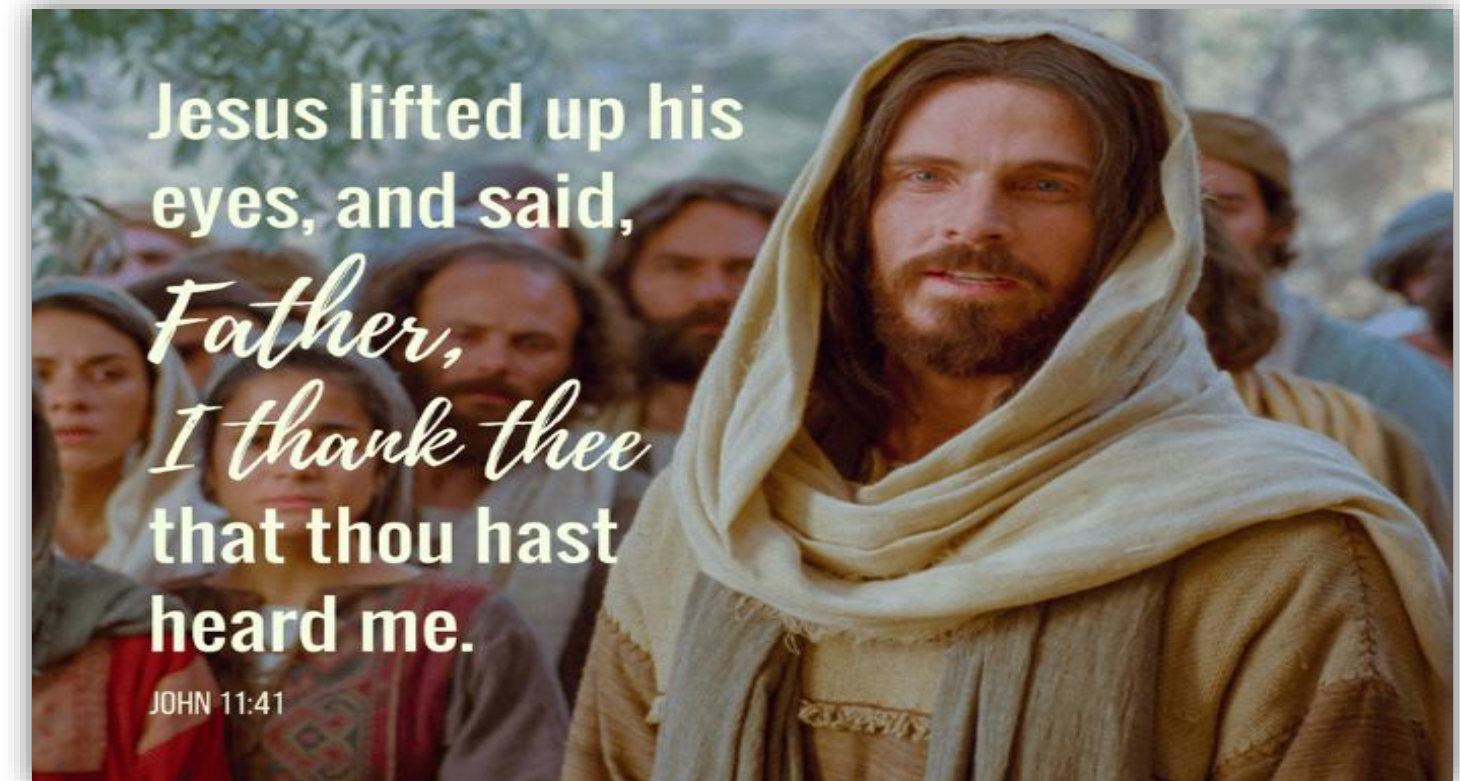
