

Saint Blaise was the bishop of Sebastea and a doctor. He is recorded as helping with patients suffering from objects stuck in their throat. Saint Blaise is believed to begin as a healer then, eventually, became a "physician of souls." He then retired to a cave, where he remained in prayer. People often turned to Saint Blaise for healing miracles. Saint Blaise is often depicted holding two crossed candles in his hand, or in a cave with wild animals.
